

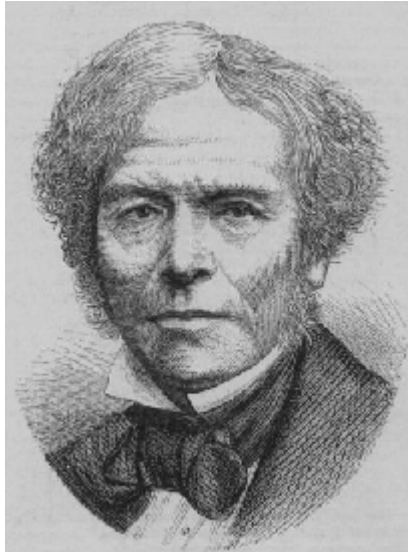

Michael Faraday (1791-1867)



Michael Faraday is a British physicist and chemist. He is famous for his discovery of electromagnetic induction and is also the inventor of the electric motor.

Michael Faraday did not receive very high formal education, but he is considered an experimentalist. He is known for his contribution in the field of electromagnetic induction, electrochemistry and also the Faraday's Law.

The unit of capacitance, the **farad**, is named after him.
