





Protein Pumps and Types of Carrier Proteins

- 1. In active transport, carrier proteins are also called **pumps** or **protein pumps**.
- 2. There are **three types** of **carrier proteins** involved in active transport.
 - Uniport one molecule is moved at a time
 - **Symport** two molecules are moved in the same direction
 - **Antiport** two molecules are moved in opposite directions
