## The importance of carbohydrates

Function	Example
Flavours and sweeteners	Sugars
Dietary fibre	Cellulose
Protection of bacterial cells	Polysaccharides in bacterial cell walls (see Figure 8.39, page 276, Nexus SPM Biology)
As culture media in the laboratory	Agar
In explosives	Cellulose nitrates
Stabilisation of the structure of proteins	Glycoproteins
Anticoagulant	Heparin
Act as markers for cell recognition; the cell as 'itself' versus foreign cells	Glycoproteins (and glycolipids) (see Figure 3.3, page 54, Nexus SPM Biology)
